

## Classroom Clarifications

The following is a similar “Classroom Clarification” that all parents and students have read and signed. This is what is expected from students in math class. All rules and regulations in the student’s handbook will also be enforced.

Homework and Exams must be done in pencil only. Math work submitted in pen will not be considered “on time homework” any work submitted in pen will be returned to students without a grade or be considered “on time status”

Homework is considered late if not turned in the day it is due.

Homework is worth 10 pts. Unless otherwise noted.

Late homework is worth a maximum of 6 pts.

Students will not be allowed to share books in class

Students will not be allowed to go to lockers during class or minutes before the bell rings.

BE PREPARED!

Tutoring will be offered during lunch or afterschool by appointment.

Students that are absent must turn in their work when they return. Work not submitted will be considered late if not turned in when the student returns to school.

Students with an approved absence will be give one extra day to submit work Unapproved absence; work will be considered late.

Students will know one week in advance about exams. The day before an exam will be a “review day,” therefore students that are absent one day before an exam will be required to take the exam when the student returns. If the student has more than one day excused absence, the student will have the same amount of days to take the exam.

**Students must show all their work! It will be the teacher’s discretion if the student shows all their work. The following are examples of complete work and not completed work.**

**Completed work:** Equation:  $2x = 6$

**Full credit**

Showing work :  $\frac{2x}{2} = \frac{6}{2}$

Boxing answer:  $x = 3$

**Incomplete work:** Equation:  $2x = 6$

**No credit**

Boxing answer:  $x=3$

**Incomplete work:**  
***No credit***
