

Tuition and Registration 2009-2010

Tuition for the 2009-2010 school year is \$6,655.00 plus a \$350 nonrefundable registration fee which is due by April 1st. Students in the Class of 2013 (incoming 9th), the registration fee is due on Monday, March 16th during registration evening. Tuition does not cover the cost of books.

Important Financial Information:

1. Parents must sign-up for the “SMART” Tuition Management Program. Returning families need only verify information and payment plan. More information will be mailed home.
2. First tuition payment is due July 5, 2009.
3. All financial obligations must be paid by May 20, 2010.
4. Families who choose to pay the annual tuition by August 1, 2009, receive a \$100.00 discount.
5. We reserve the right to withhold tests, grades, and diplomas until all financial, academic and disciplinary obligations have been met.
6. Each student is expected to sell or purchase \$80.00 in Fiesta tickets, as well as families to contribute 25 hours of service or a “service buy-out” of \$250.00.
7. Due to an excessive number of leftover yearbooks, the yearbook will need to be pre-ordered in January 2010 at an additional per student fee of \$60.00.
8. Seniors are required to pay a graduation fee of \$125.00, and is due May 1, 2010.

Tuition payments are spread over eleven months beginning in July and ending in May. **All tuition and fees are nonrefundable.**

HomeLogic access, www access, PSAT/ EXPLORE testing fees, xeroxing in library, I.D. card, school newspaper, freshmen and sophomore retreats, science lab fees, guest speakers, school website, library subscriptions, campus ministry events, admission to home athletic events, student school insurance, CIF dues for athletes, clubs and organizations and the school planner/handbook.
